# APPLICATION AND CONTRACT FOR 2009-2010 SEASON PASSES

## ABOUT BUYING A 2009-2010 SEASON PASS

Welcome to Blue Mountain! Whether you are a long time season pass holder or purchasing for the first time, here are some answers to questions you may have:

### 1. How do I apply for a season pass?

#### \*Payment must be made by valid credit card.

If you are paying by cheque, please make it payable to **Blue Mountain Resort Limited**. Returned cheques are subject to a \$25.00 administration fee. If you are a new applicant, proof of birthdate must be presented for Youth, Senior Citizen and Tiny Tyke applicants. Photocopies of birth certificates will be accepted. Where possible, please submit the copy with your application to speed up the process of issuing passes.

### 2. Where do I pick up my pass?

Each pass holder needs to pick up his/her pass in person, as the pass consists of a photograph and each applicant must personally sign a Release of Liability Waiver. Signature of parent or legal guardian required if under 18 years of age. Passes may be picked up at Blue Mountain Resorts Guest Services office any time after September 8, 2009. Office hours are from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, seven days a week. Applications must be processed prior to issuing a pass.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**Each applicant agrees with Blue Mountain Resorts Limited, that in consideration of the applicant purchasing a Season Pass, to be bound by the following terms and conditions.**

- REFUNDS:** A Season Pass Purchaser who has not picked up and or received value from the pass may obtain a full refund of price paid for the Season Pass for any reason on or before December 1st, 2009. Unless a written request for the refund is received by Blue Mountain Resorts Limited on or before that date, Blue Mountain will not provide a refund or credit for any reason on a Season Pass.
- INSURANCE\*:** Protect your investment in your Season Pass. Risk is a natural part of skiing/snowboarding and accidents can happen. Sure-ski will refund Season Pass fees to any covered person should injury, long-term sickness or death (any of which occurring on or off the ski hill) prevent you from being able to ski or snowboard for more than 30 consecutive days within the ski season. Sure-ski is very affordable at just 5.4% of the Season Pass cost. Minimum of \$10.80. **You can't afford to ski/snowboard without it!**

\* Sure-Ski Season Pass insurance must be purchased at time of pass purchase. All claims must be submitted within 45 days of accident date. See the Sure-ski brochure for more details.

- All Season Pass purchasers will be required to sign a release of liability waiver when picking up their pass, unless such pass was purchased on-line, as such purchasers will be required to agree to the terms of the release of liability at the time of purchase. Signature of parent or legal guardian is required for pass holders under 18 years of age.**

### 4. How long is the ski season and what are the operating hours?

The length of the ski season is dependent on weather and snow conditions, but generally Blue Mountain is open from December to the end of March. Day skiing 9:00am - 4:30pm. Night skiing 4:30pm - 10:00pm

**Super Pass** is valid for lift access during normal operating hours 9am - 10pm for the 2009-2010 season.\*

**5 X 7 Pass** is valid for lift access\*

- 5 days a week Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 4:30pm (excluding Saturday December 19, 2009 through Sunday January 3, 2010).
- 7 nights a week from 4:30pm to 10:00pm. The night season is scheduled to start Thursday December 17, 2009 and will end on Sunday March 21, 2010.

**Night Value Pass** is valid for lift access\*

- 5 nights a week Sunday through Thursday from 4:30pm to 10:00pm Starting Sunday January 3, 2010.
- The night season is scheduled to start Thursday December 17, 2009 and will end on Sunday March 21, 2010.

**5 X 7 Lift & Equipment Pass** is valid for lift access and use of Sport Rental Equipment\*

- 5 days a week Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 4:30pm (excluding Saturday December 19, 2009 through Sunday January 3, 2010).
- 7 nights a week from 4:30pm to 10:00pm. The night season is scheduled to start Thursday December 17, 2009 and will end on Sunday March 21, 2010.
- Use of Sport Ski/Snowboard rental are limited to same restrictions as above. Rental Equipment use is subject to availability and must be returned at the end of each day.

**Badlands Terrain Park Pass** is valid during all park operating hours for the 2009 - 2010 season.\*

#### • HELMETS ARE MANDATORY IN ALL TERRAIN PARKS!

- Pass holders must be 8 years or older to enter into the Park.
- Read and follow all posted signage.

**Double Down** entitles you to:

- Two single use tickets to be used during the 2009/10 winter season. No refunds or exchanges.
- Limit of two Double Down card per customer.
- Only available to purchase until November 1, 2009.

**Resort facilities** will operate daily at the discretion of management. There shall be no refunds or compensation in case of cancellation of operations on account of weather, conditions or mechanical failure of equipment.

### 5. When skiing, how is my pass to be worn?

All passes come with a lanyard and a clip. Passes must be worn visibly and properly attached on the front of your jacket while you are skiing and must not be attached to your gloves or hat.

### 6. What if I forget my pass?

If you forget your season pass, the Guest Services and Season Pass office will issue you a complimentary ski ticket the first time only. After that, you will be required to purchase a regular price ski ticket. Should a "forgotten pass ticket" be found on a person other than the rightful owner, the season pass will be revoked without refund.

### 7. What if I lose my pass?

If you lose your pass, report it immediately to the Guest Services and Season Pass office. It may have been found. After 1 week we will re-print your pass for free the first time only. If it is lost again there will be a \$25.00 administration fee.

### 8. This Pass remains the property of Blue Mountain Resorts Limited. Season Passes can not be transferred to another person once they've been printed.

### 9. As a pass holder, I agree:

- a) to read and understand Blue Mountain's "Alpine Responsibility Code" and Ticket Removal Policy and agree to abide by it.
- b) not to teach skiing for remuneration
- c) not to transfer my pass to another person.

I understand that the breach of this contract is a serious offense. Should a pass be found on a person other than the owner of the pass, both owner and user will be expelled from Blue Mountain property and the pass will be revoked without refund.
